

The Virginia Junior Angus Board of Directors and Officers would like for the Board members to take a more active role in their organization with a little more responsibility than in the past and better prepare them for stepping up to hold offices in the future. With this in mind, it was determined in the last board meeting to structure the 6 board member positions into chairmanships. Please read the following and be prepared to take on these responsibilities if you apply for a position. These Chair positions are –

1. Jr Beef Round-Up Chairperson

Responsible for working with Advisors to send out entry forms (or get them put on the VA Angus website for downloading); order ribbons and awards; coordinate ring help, ready ring help and an announcer. Assist Advisors with setting up the State Showmanship Competition and finding individuals to judge this event.

2. Breeders Show Chairperson

Responsible for working with Advisors to send out entry forms (or get them put on the VA Angus website for downloading); order ribbons and awards; coordinate ring help, ready ring help and an announcer; coordinate during the show and other junior events, encouraging Junior members to participate in the additional activities

3. State Fair Chairperson

Responsible for working with Advisors to order awards; coordinate ring help, ready ring help and an announcer; and coordinate other junior events during the show

4. Eastern Regional Chairperson

Responsible for encouraging Virginia Juniors to work together as a team – keeping the stall areas clean and presentable, tying out at the same time and cleaning the stalls – coordinating teams of junior to clean tie-outs each day. Coordinating with the advisors to get Stall Cards to coordinate with the theme for Eastern Regional. Touch base with the family(s) building the display to see about bringing it to the Eastern Regional.

5.&6. National Junior Show Chairpersons

Responsible for encouraging Virginia Juniors to work together as a team – keeping the stall areas clean and presentable, being hospitable to visitors to the Virginia stalls, tying out at the same time and cleaning the stalls – coordinating the teams of juniors to clean tie-outs each day. ALSO, helping to keep track of who is competing in which contest on which day! Coordinating with the Display family(s) and the advisors to get Stall Cards to coordinate with the theme for Nationals. Display – responsible for coordinating with the family(s) who is(are) designing / building the display to get it to Nationals. Encouraging juniors to watch their fellow VA Jr members compete both in the ring and in the contests.
